Cool Season Turfs

- *Can use less water than most xeriscape plants.
- *Are very traffic tolerant.
- *Can survive heat stress.
- *Produce more oxygen than trees, shrubs and flowers.
- *Remove dust and dirt from the air.
- *2500 sq. ft. of turf grass releases enough for a family of 4, per day.
- *On a hot day, turf areas will be 15-30 degrees cooler than decks, patios, shrub beds, dirt areas and walkways.
- *Act as a natural filter, it reduces pollutions by purifying water passing through the root zone.
- *Eight front lawns have the cooling effect of a 70 ton air conditioner.
- *According to US Water Resources Council, lawn watering, swimming pools and automobile washing accounts for 27.5% of a household's total water usages.
